



# CATTLE RESPECT PROGRAM (C.R.P.I)

VSPCA'S CATTLE RESPECT PROGRAM INDIA IS A HOLISTIC AND COMPREHENSIVE INITIATIVE ADDRESSING PROBLEMS CATTLE FACE:

- CATTLE TRAFFICKING WITHIN/ACROSS STATE'S BORDERS
- ILLEGAL SLAUGHTER OF CATTLE AND EQUINES
- HORRIFIC ANIMAL MANAGEMENT AT SHANTIES/ANIMAL MARKETS, TRADE ROUTES, AND UNDER PRIVATE OWNERSHIP

### SAVING SIMHACHALAM CALVES

SAVING THE SIMHACHALAM CALVES HAS BEEN VSPCA'S TARGETED MISSION FOR TWO-AND-A-HALF DECADES. OUR VIGIL PERSISTS AGAINST MIDDLEMEN WHO CONSIGN THESE ANIMALS TO SLAUGHTER.

WITH COMMUNITY-CENTRIC EFFORTS, WE WERE SUCCESSFUL IN BRINGING DOWN THE ANNUAL CALF ABANDONMENT NUMBERS FROM 25,000 BACK IN 2000S, TO 3000 IN THE YEAR 2020. THIS IS DIRECTLY ATTRIBUTED TO OUR DOOR-TO-DOOR CAMPAIGN IN VILLAGES THAT REVERE SIMHACHALAN DEITIES

WE PRIMARILY EDUCATE TO RE-SENSITIZE THE DEVOTEES AT THE TEMPLE SITE, WHERE CALVES ARE ABANDONED, BY SHOWCASING THE ATROCIOUS CONSEQUENCES FACED BY DAYS-OLD CALVES LEFT AT THE GOD'S ALTARS.

REACHING ABANDONMENT STATS OF 3000, HAS MOTIVATED OUR TEAM TO KEEP OUR GOAL AS ZERO DONATION OF CALVES TO SIMHACHALAM BY DEVOTEES

RESCUING AND REHABILITATING THE CALVES IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THIS PROJECT, WHERE WE RESCUE NUMEROUS CALVES FROM TRAFFICKING, ACCIDENTS AND NEGLECT, ENROUTE TO SIMHACHALAN, AND WORK WITH FARMER COOPS TO TAKE THEM IN AND MAINTAIN THEM UN-EXPLOITATIVELY, YET USEFULLY - MANUFACTURING FERTILIZER AND GROUND CLEANER FROM THEIR DUNG

### ONE-STOP COMMUNITY DOG-FEEDING STATIONS

SINCE THE PANDEMIC, SCARCITY OF FOOD IS IMPACTING STREET ANIMAL BEHAVIOR AND HEALTH. VSPCA HAS INCREASINGLY GROWN ITS ESTABLISHED AND ORGANIZED NETWORKS OF 'COMMUNITY DOG' FEEDING STATIONS IN VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CITY, WHERE THERE IS SERIOUS COMPETITION FOR FOOD AMONG COMMUNITY ANIMALS.

TODAY, WE HAVE DEDICATED SERVICES AND SERVICE PROVIDERS HELPING US THROUGH THE DAY, WITH AN INCREASED NUMBER OF FEEDING STATIONS WE'VE ESTABLISHED. SINCE THE MUNICIPALITY EXACERBATED THE ALIENATION OF DOGS, MIXING UP THESE TERRITORIAL ANIMALS IN DIFFERENT NEIGHBORHOODS DURING THE PANDEMIC, OUR FEEDING STATIONS ARE KEY TO DOG HEALTH AND REDUCED HUMAN-ANIMAL CONFLICTS.

NON-DAIRY VEGAN MEALS ARE
DISTRIBUTED TO NEGLECTED, ABANDONED,
SPECIALLY-ABLED MENTALLY CHALLENGED,
AND MARGINALIZED INDIVIDUALS VIA OUR
"KINDNESS MOBILE RESTAURANT."

MOST OF THESE INDIVIDUALS HAVE ADOPTED COMMUNITY ANIMALS, SENDING URBANITES A MESSAGE OF PURE LOVE AND COMPASSION TOWARDS ALL BEINGS. VSPCA URGES OUR RECOGNITION OF SUCH GENEROSITY, ESPECIALLY WHEN ONE HAS NO MATERIAL POSSESSIONS.

### AWARENESS, EDUCATION, AND OUTREACH - DEFYING SPECIESISM!

Awareness and Education Outreach is an effective tool VSPCA applies to resolve real-time challenges exploiting animals and Mother Nature.

Protection of the Environment, preserving ecological relationships in Nature, and safeguarding the last remaining natural habitat for all species is paramount for VSPCA.

Effective campaigns undertaken by VSPCA are :-

- Promotion of <u>Animal Birth Control</u> over brutal culling of community animals.
- Campaigning to <u>halt Olive Ridley Turtle poaching</u>.
   Thereby, <u>inspiring the fisher community to drive community-led conservation initiatives and measures</u>.
- Sensitizing communities in order to <u>rid ourselves</u>
   of <u>superstitions and bad omens held against</u>
   <u>street cats</u>, encouraging their acceptance among
   the people. This has eliminated the widespread
   culling of stray and feral cats.
- <u>Liberating cobras, parakeets, star tortoises,</u> <u>monkeys, and other trafficked wildlife</u> from the clutches of performers and poachers.
- Campaigning against plastic ingestion by cows under the <u>Plastic Cow</u> program.
- Bringing Awareness in Rural Communities, through animal markets, to maintain standards & facilities for animals, avoiding their inhumane display/trafficking & illegal slaughter.

### LIBERATION OF WILDLIFE

VSPCA is vigilant for the cause of <u>wildlife</u> <u>liberation</u>. We make effort to <u>re-wild</u> <u>animals</u> after rescuing them from the clutches of poachers, wildlife trappers, street entertainers, etc. where animals are forced to perform illegally.

Parrot astrologers, snake charmers, poachers, and traffickers are people we confront repeatedly to confiscate and busts their networked operations, resulting in the liberation of various species in Scheduled Lists, which have been rehabilitated and rewilded.

Over the years, stats and reporting show a steady decline in occurrences of wildlife trapping in the city, which has been attributed to our relentless efforts and strong vigil against wildlife crimes in our region.

# **VSPCA SHELTER & SANCTUARIES**

Shelters and Sanctuaries play a crucial role in mitigating the suffering of distressed and rescued animal residents of the city.

The upkeep of animals at the shelter - their <u>rescue</u>, <u>rehabilitation</u>, and <u>re-homing</u>; and additionally, <u>caring for specially-abled animals</u>, performing <u>spay-neuter surgeries</u>, and <u>ensuring shelter-sustaining</u> <u>activities</u>, remain among our biggest challenge.

VSPCA has been doggedly pursuing revenue generation through product manufacturing, despite combating natural calamities.

### PEDIGREE DOG PARADISE

The issue with <u>Abandoned Pedigrees</u>
<u>Dogs</u> is highly distressing becoming a thorn in the holistic welfare of all dogs.

Abandoned non-spayed and unvaccinated dogs are at high risk of casualties while creating greater vulnerability among community dog populations, with the potential rise of both, diseases and dog-dog/human-dog conflicts. VSPCA worked to resolve this issue by establishing a facility for Rescue/Rehabilitation of Abandoned Dogs. It is now a model for city governments with large dog populations and unused open areas. With this facility, we have the capacity to rescue and shelter abandoned dogs, re-home them to their forever families, or shelter them permanently.

Most of the dog housing construction is complete with trees and recreation facilities (swimming pools, burial grounds, play areas, individual bungalows, etc.)

As the facility is fully operational, it will serve as a demonstrable mechanism for resolving the issue of abandoned pedigree dogs.

### BIOPHILIC VISAKHAPATNAM

Biophilic Visakhapatnam is a pioneering initiative to safeguard the city's natural and green spaces and integrate interspecies / human-animal co-existence scenarios within urban ecology and the ecosystems in the district of Visakhapatnam.

Biophilic Cities Network (a global organization headquartered in VA, USA) brings together planners, architects, conservationists, scientists, and activists with a mission to rebuild greener cities and enhance inter-species co-existence in urban landscapes.

VSPCA representing Visakhapatnam city, is an ally within the Biophilic Cities Network, launching and pioneering the Initiative Biophilic Visakhapatnam, a first of its kind in India.

Under this initiative, VSPCA is working in habitat restoration, rejuvenation, and preservation of destructed landscapes helping re-brown/blue/green Visakhapatnam city under the universal laws of interspecies coexistence.

#### **NATURAL CALAMITIES**

Natural Calamities have been relentless over the city of Visakhapatnam. The city has been ravaged by depression, cyclones incessant rains, and heat waves. This region is prone to depressions and cyclones often, due to low-pressure area formations in the ocean.

This year we were hit with depression seven times, with several downpours of unprecedented rainfall.

VSPCA shelters were often hit by flash floods, submerging low-lying areas, turning them into swamp.

VSPCA staff strive to avoid casualties. However, safeguarding the animals and securing the infrastructure and their food resources, has become a significant challenge.

We strive to minimize the losses; however, the damage this time has never been seen before.

# SAFEGUARDING AND PROVIDING SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO NEGLECTED CATTLE

During the period between September and January 2022, we confronted a serious issue, where over 500 cows, calves, and bulls were confiscated by various groups at key trafficking arteries. The cattle were dumped in the local "gaushala" (cow pens) with a housing capacity for 40 Animals.

Periodically, confiscated cattle from various District Police Stations destined cattle to this gaushala, where none of the groups spared a hand in taking care of the animals! Without proper management and intense neglect, hundreds of cattle were dying of malnutrition, prolonged illness, and trauma. VSPCA intervened to manage the situation providing medical assistance to over 450 bovine. We rehabilitated the sick, disabled, and orphaned calves to various shelters in the city and monitored resident cattle to recovery.
